Naming convention of the tracks

[2 digits: day][1 digit: sort number][name]

040 Merzouga – Dadès (TMT): Main route for day 4 (sort number 0 is the main track)

041 Off-road loop Merzouga 1 (+140 min): Additional off-road loop for day 4

043 RPI504 shortcut (-25 min): Shortcut for day 4 in case you want to skip a part to save time

Garmin XT/XT2

If you're using a Garmin device (such as the XT or XT2), it's best to use the generated GPX files (one GPX file per day). These daily GPX files are created with my POI2PIC tool. POI2PIC adds custom icons and symbols for waypoints and POIs, and it combines all tracks per day using different track colors.

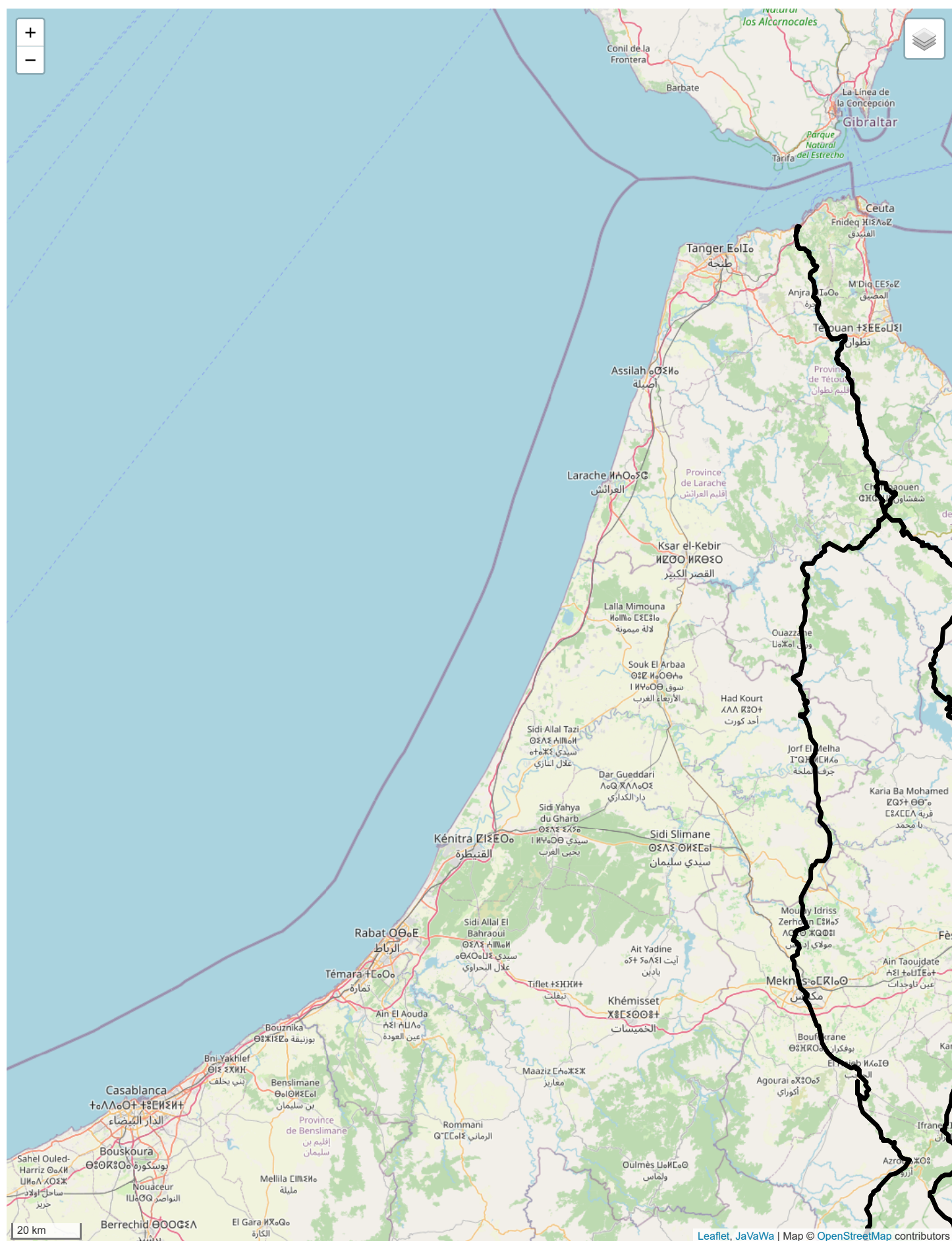
Place each daily GPX file into a separate collection, create a route based on the main track for that day, and navigation becomes incredibly simple!

The GPX files comply with GPX standards, but I'm not sure how well this works on other devices besides the XT and XT2.

P.S. Using these tracks with TomTom is pointless: TomTom tries to match them to existing roads, which will fail!

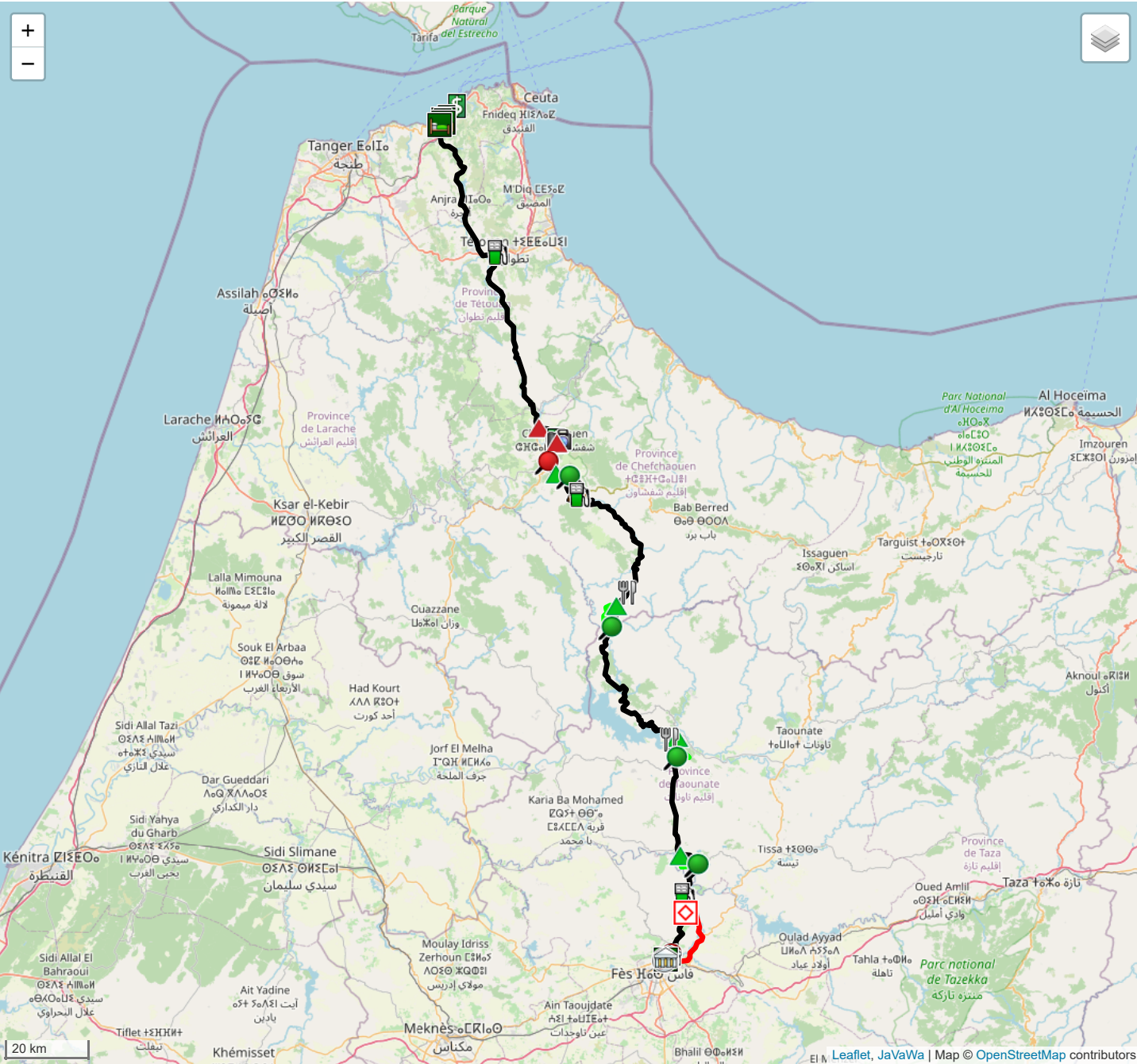

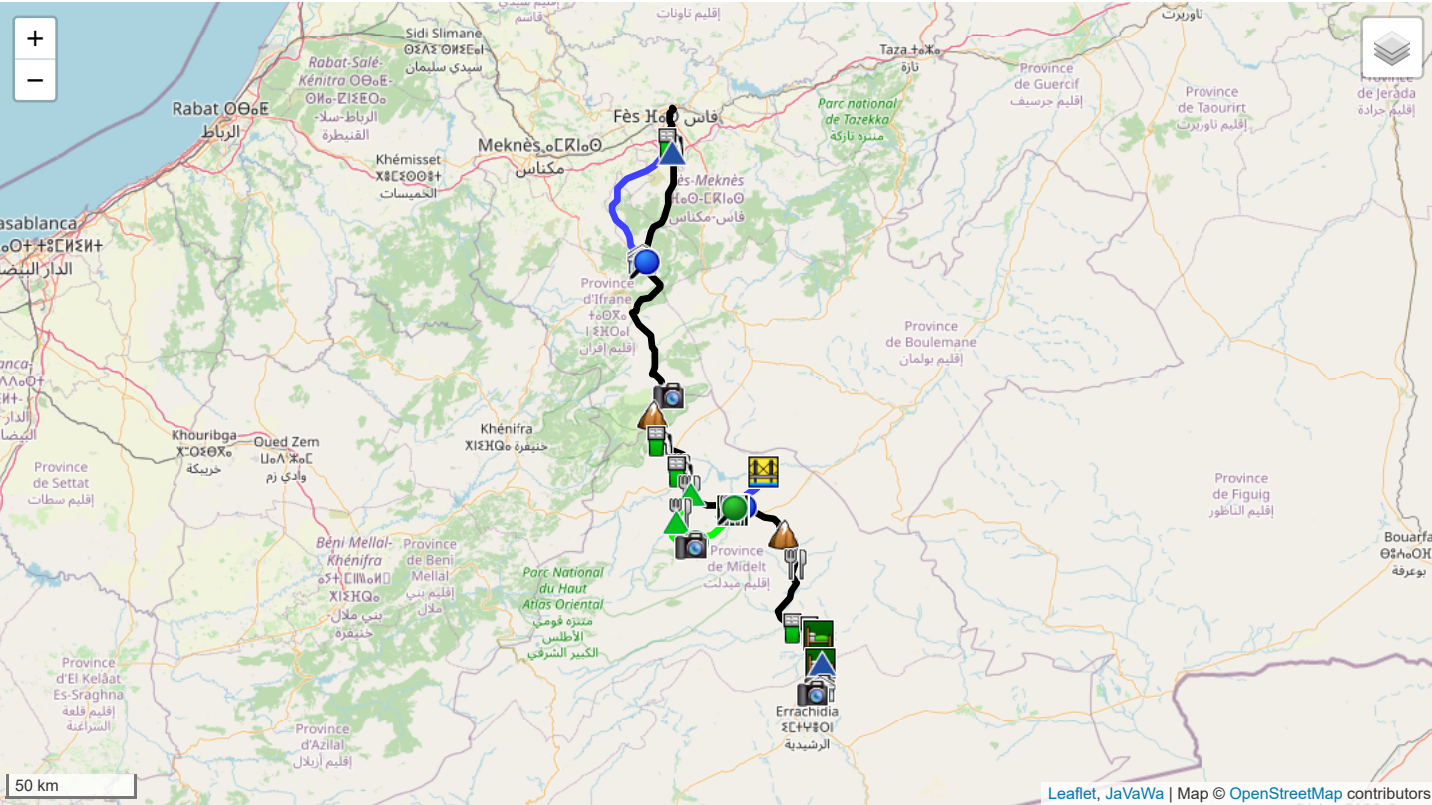
Fuel

There is enough fuel available along the route until about halfway; after that, there is nothing until Fez.

Info

The route is almost entirely paved, except for a few short optional stretches and a bigger section at the end (do not drive when wet), with a stopover in Chefchaouen (the Blue City). Opportunities to have lunch along the way are quite limited. In Fez (one of the four "imperial cities" and the cultural capital of Morocco), the preferred hotel has a guarded parking area in the Medina (old town).

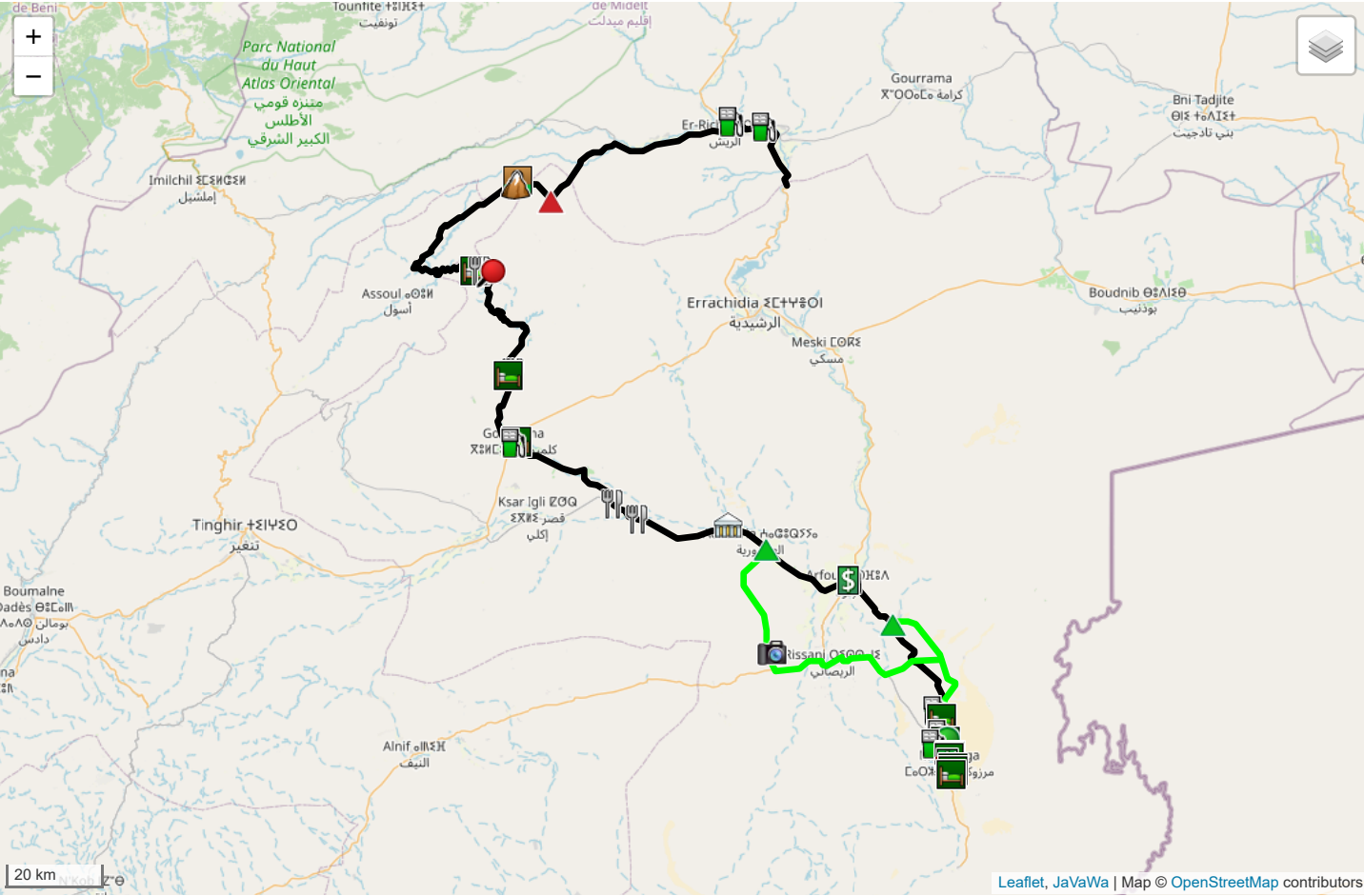
Fuel

Plenty of fuel available along the way.

Info

The main route is paved, except for the section south of the Cirque du Jaafar (optional). The Canyon itself is a very hard part for heavy motorcycles. The alternative routes are partially unpaved. The Ziz Valley extension involves driving back and forth.

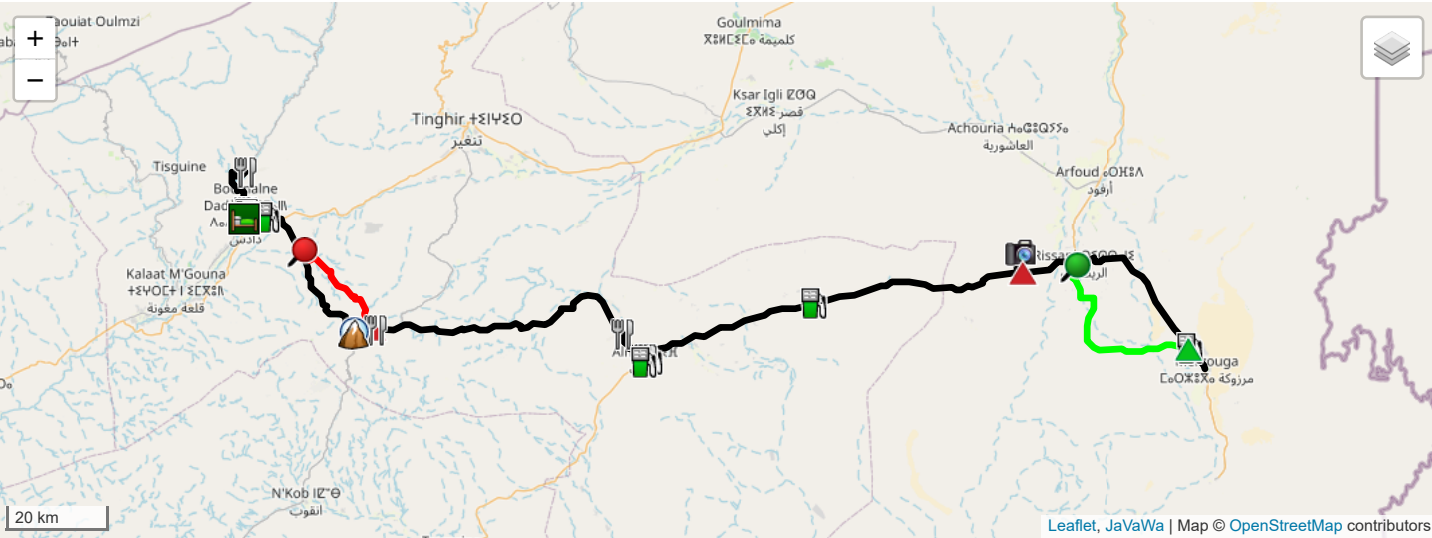
There is enough fuel available along the way.

Info

The route is mostly paved, except for the Tagountsa Pass. Gara Medouar is optional and, according to other riders, takes a maximum of 90 to 120 minutes, including a stop and photo moments (according to MRA, this is almost 3 hours). It can also be done the next day if needed.

It's advisable to arrive in Merzouga on time to view the Sahara dunes. The final destination, Merzouga, is located at the edge of Erg Chebbi—a desert area with dunes up to 150 meters high.

Plenty of fuel available along the route. Fill up the tank and withdraw cash upon entering Dades (there is no ATM for the next two days).

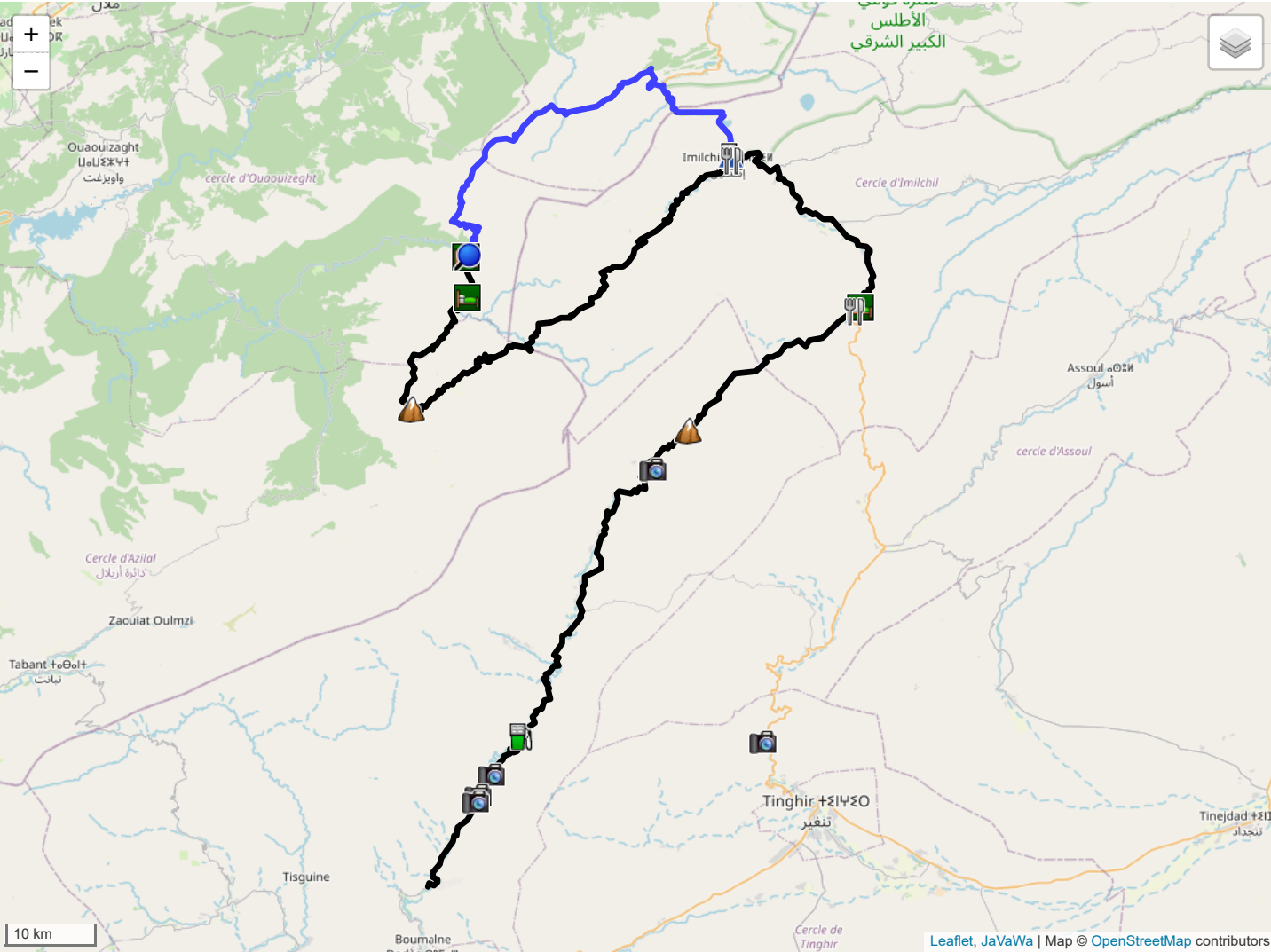
The Merzouga off-road loop is a TMT route and likely very sandy (we did not ride this one). If we've already visited Gara Medouar, it saves about 45 minutes.

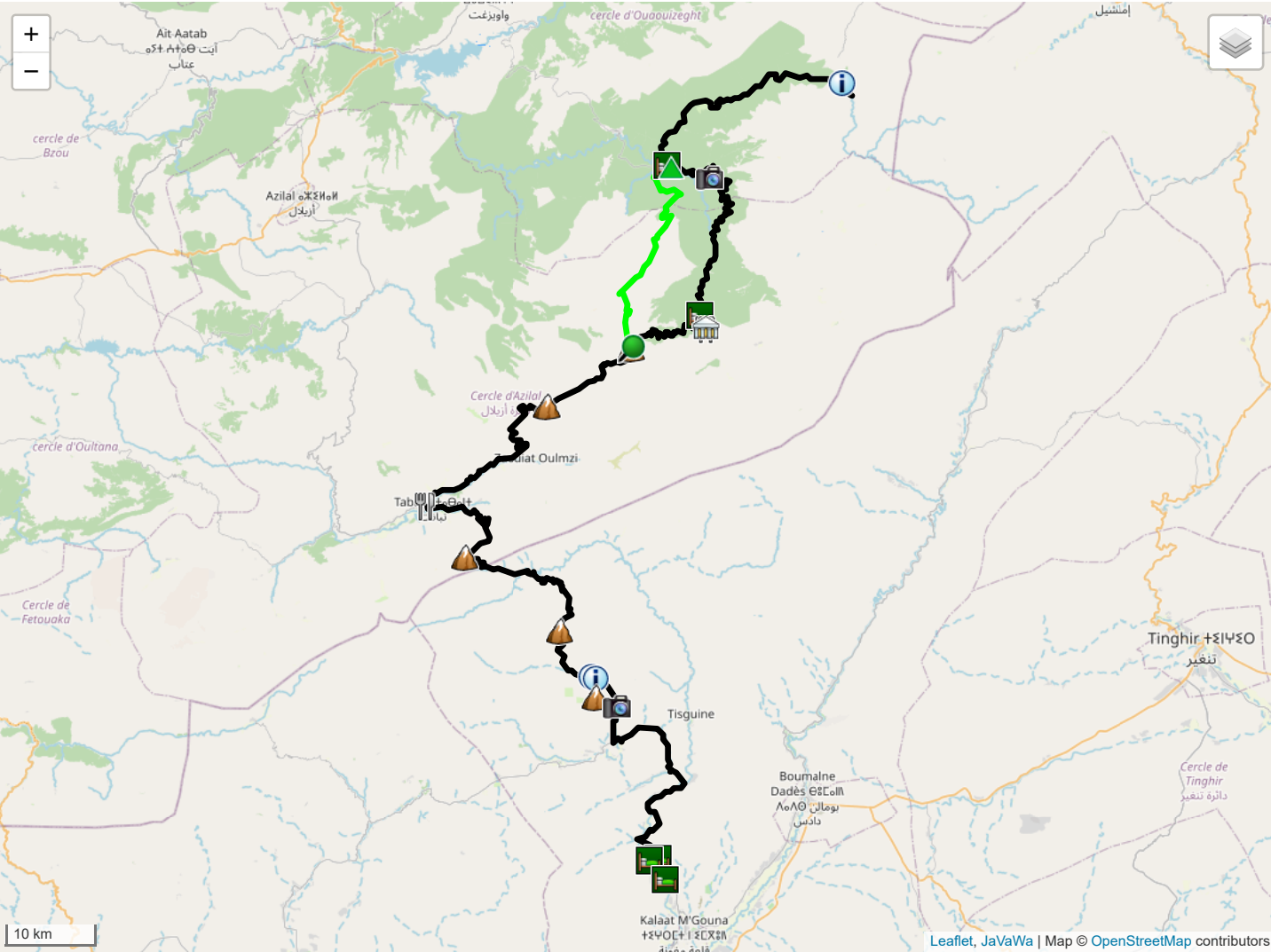
The route for this day passes through the Dades Valley and the Dades Gorge. The second half is off-road. (The GPX track actually shows 25 km less distance than MRA)

Fuel

A normal fuel station can only be found at Kalaat M'Gouna. We made it with 20 km left in our tank. According to TMT, fuel is available in the villages of Imsfrane, Zaouiat Ahansal, Tabant/Ait Bouguemez and Alemdoun, but you need to ask for it.

Info

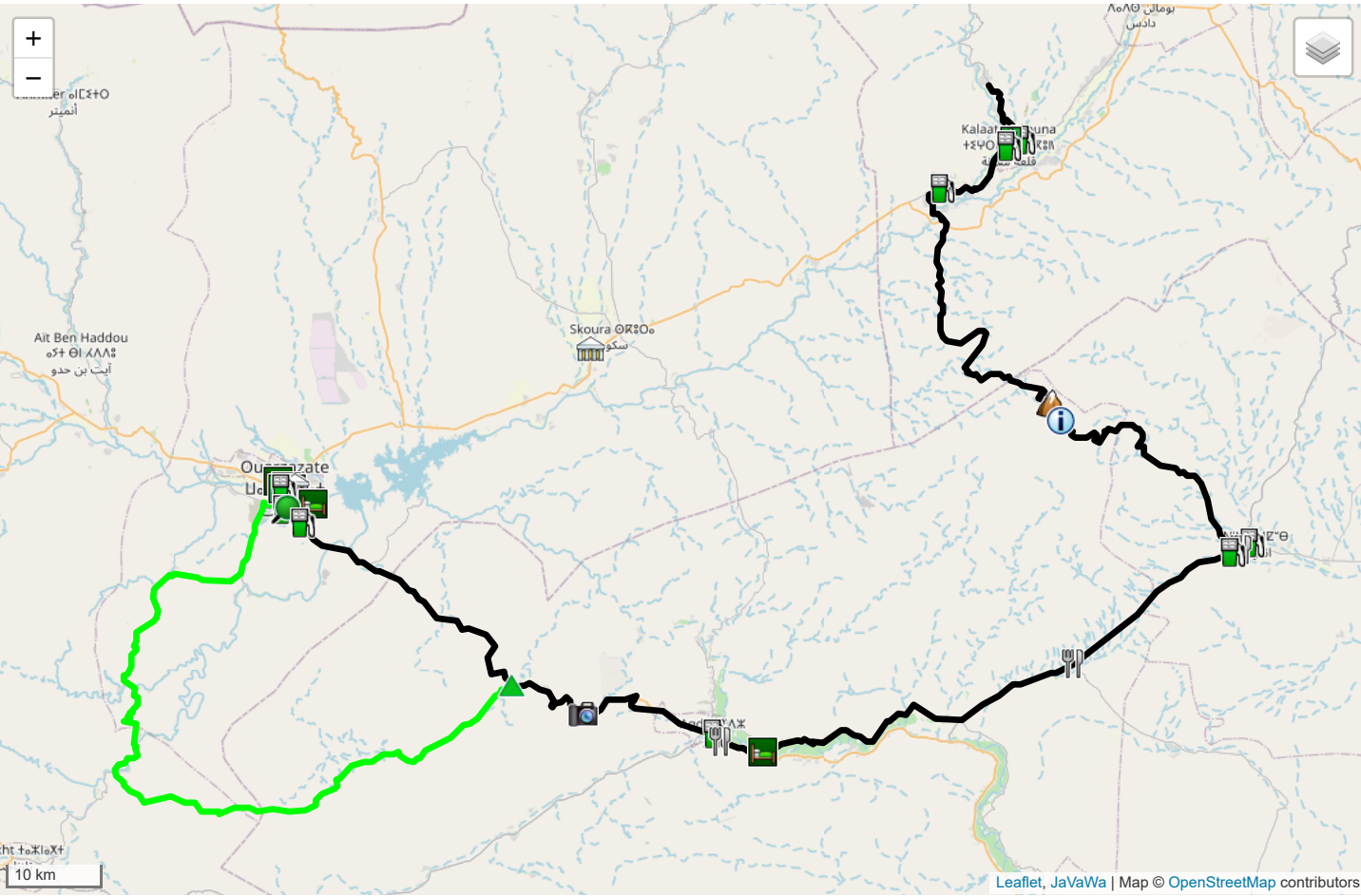
Many high mountain passes. At the end of the day, we arrive at the Gorges d'Amejjag. We'll stay overnight in the Vallée des Roses (accommodation before that is scarce and basic). The last place to have lunch is after about 4 hours of riding.

P: gravel tracks, high elevations (20% off-road)

Note: OpenStreetMap shows a distance of 340 km for this track (possibly a bug?), that's why the main track is split up into 2 tracks.

The first gas station is 15 minutes in. After that, fuel is fairly available (refuel if at half tank).

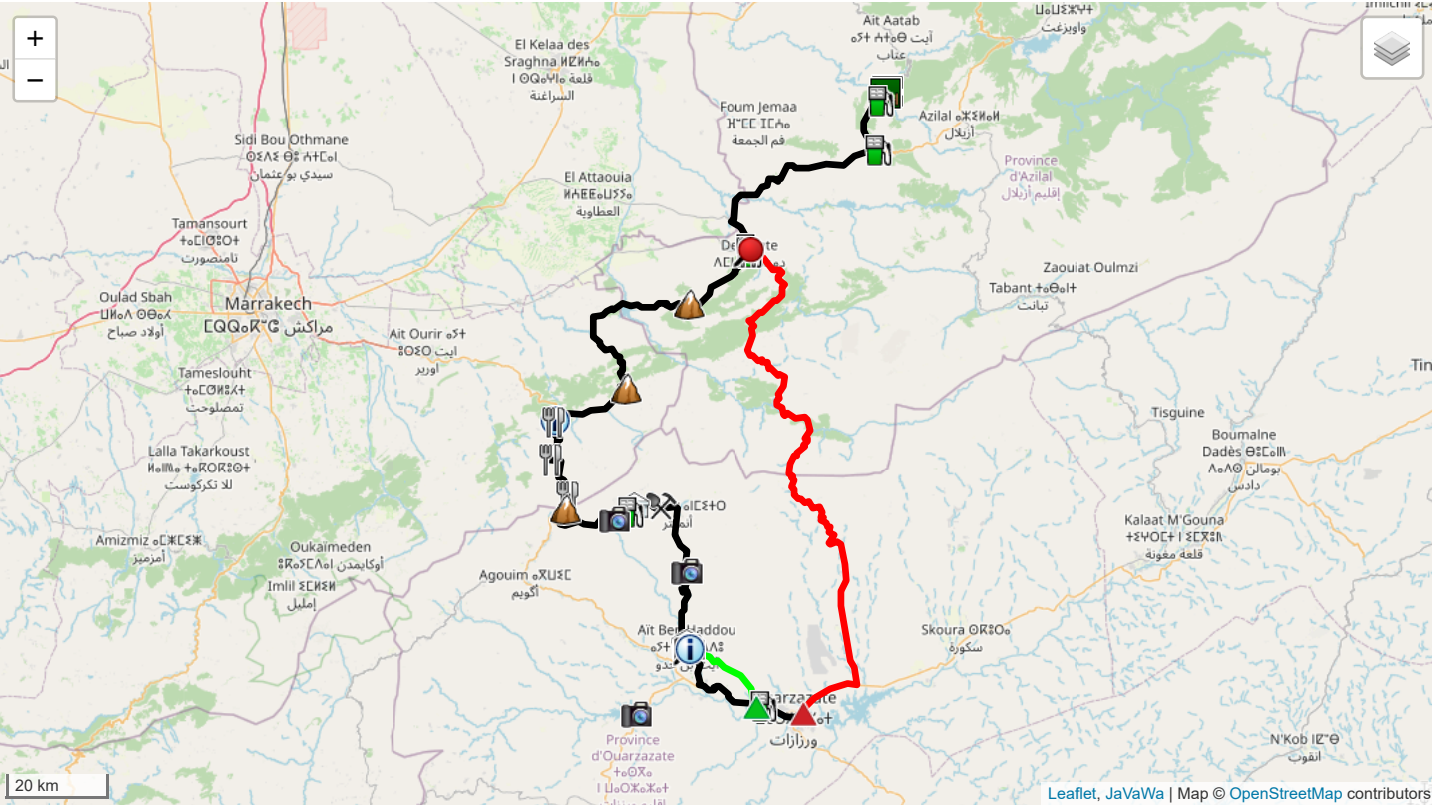
Info

Last day of the TMT. The first half of the day is off-road, followed by a paved road through the Draa Valley to the "Route of a Thousand Kasbahs." In Ouarzazate, we can stay overnight within walking distance of Kasbah Taourirt.

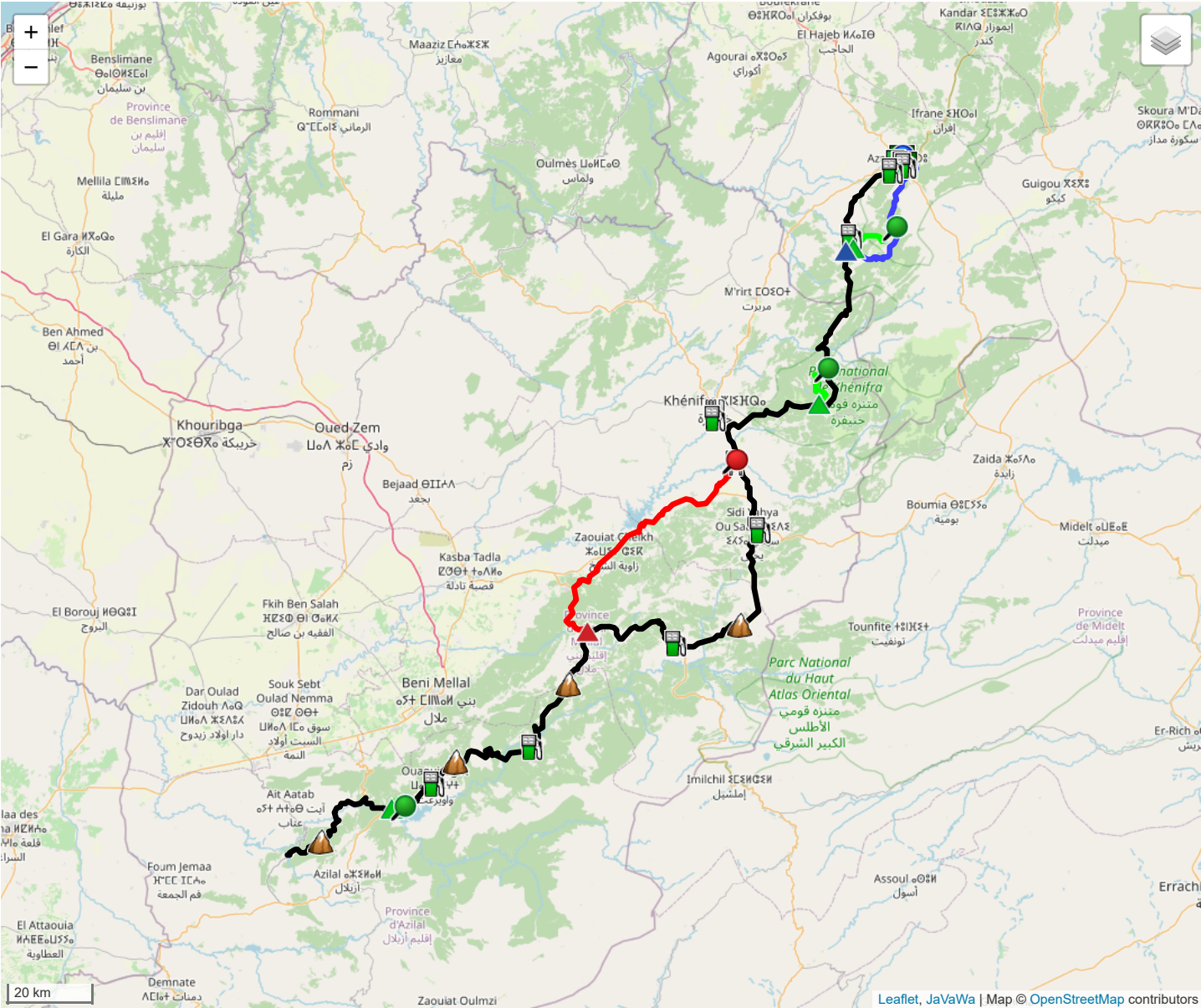

Withdraw cash for two days before departure (no ATMs until Meknes). "The Route of a Thousand Kasbahs" takes us past Ksar Ait Ben Haddou (famous from Game of Thrones) and Kasbah Telouet. We'll also pass some beautiful mountain passes. The preferred hotel in Ouzoud is located near the Ouzoud Waterfalls.

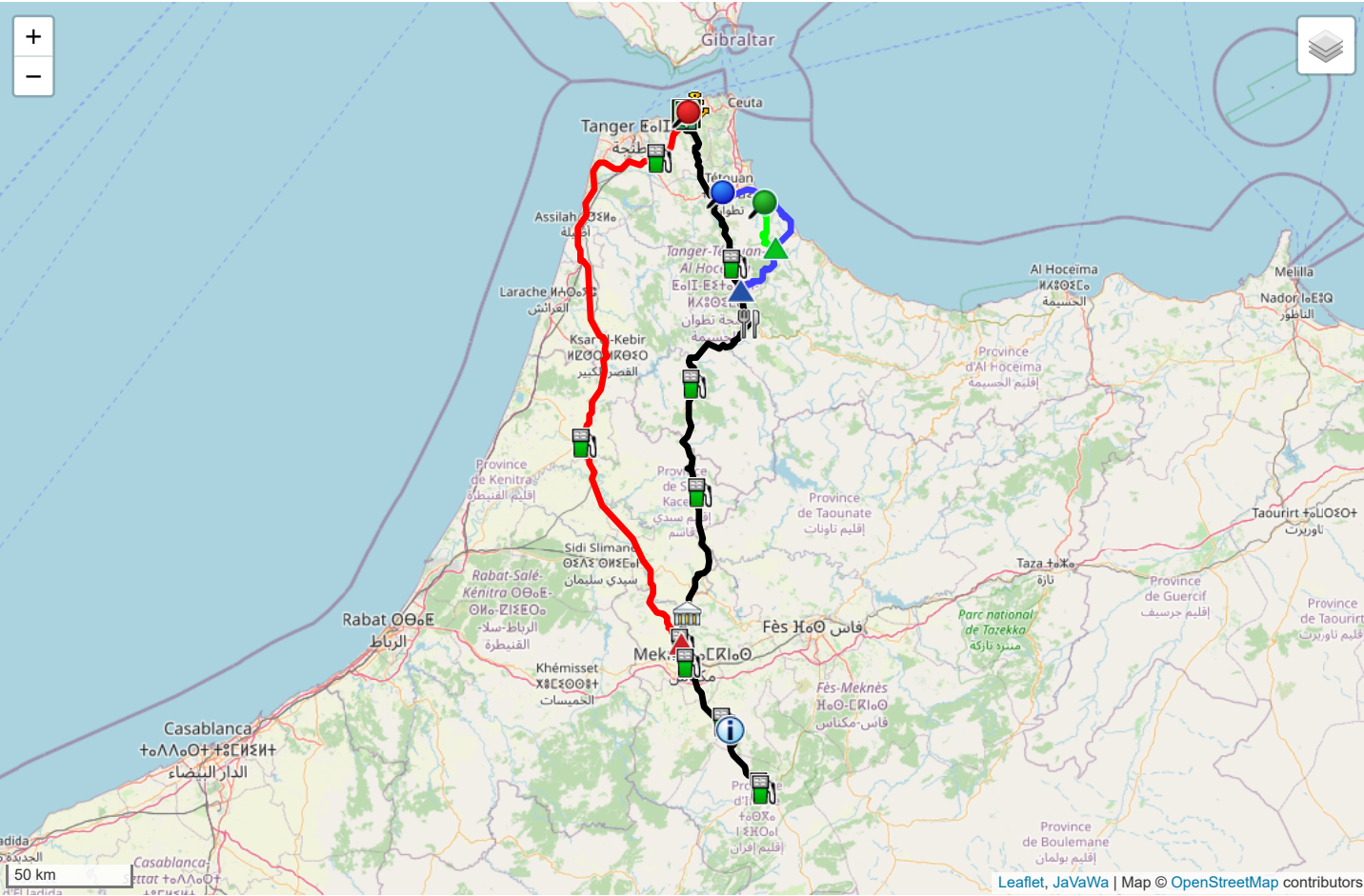
